RE: FORMER POLICY 4040 STUDENT ACCIDENT AND ILLNESS

REGULATIONS

- 1. Transportation shall be provided or arranged by the parent if possible and practical.
- 2. In the event that an ambulance service is required, the Board will assume the fee levied by the Emergency Health Services Commission.
- 3. Transportation by School District employees is to be avoided if possible. Where an emergent situation requires transportation by Administrative Officer or teacher, this should if possible, be cleared with the parent or guardian and, if deemed necessary, by medical authorities.
- 4. An Administrative Officer or teacher who wishes to seek reimbursement for expenses incurred in providing transportation as specified in 2. shall discuss the circumstances with the Superintendent who has the authority to approve such payment.
- 5. Unless otherwise approved through written consent, School District personnel shall not sign consent forms in connection with hospital or other medical attention for students.
- 6. No internal medication shall be given to any student without written approval of the parent/guardian and the direction and training of the school health nurse and/or the doctor associated with the student.
